CONDITIONS OF CONSENT

1. This consent is valid only for the approved production capacity of Sugar Cane- 10,000 TCD and 39.7 MW Power Co-Generation .
- 2(a) . The maximum rate of emission of flue gas should not be more than the emission norms for the stacks.

- 2(b) . The emissions by various stacks into the environment should be as per the norms of the Board .

- 3 . Quantity of other pollutants should also be as per the norms prescribed by the Board/MOEF & CC/or otherwise mandatory .
- 4 . The equipment for air pollution control system and monitoring ,as proposed by the industry and approved by the Board should be installed in their premises itself .
- 5 . The modification or installation in the existing pollution control equipments should be done only by prior approval of Board .
- 6 . The operation of air pollution control system and maintenance be done in such a way that the quantity of pollutants should be in accordance with the standards prescribed by the Board/MoEF & CC/or otherwise mandatory .
- 7 . Unit should do provisions for fugitive emissions chimney/stack as per the norms of the Board/MOEF & CC/or otherwise mandatory .
- 8 . The unit should submit the stack emissions monitoring report within one month from issuance of consent order along with the point wise compliance report of the consent order . Further quarterly monitoring report should be submitted .

Specific Conditions:

Ensure Strict compliance with the conditions mentioned in the Consent Order and submit compliance report within one month from receipt of this letter.

1. This consent is valid for the maximum Sugar Cane crushing capacity-10,000 TPD. and 39.7 MW of Power Co-Generation.
2. Industry shall submit monitoring report of Flue Gas Emission and Ambient Air Quality, from NABL accredited laboratory within 03 months.
3. Industry shall ensure proper operation and maintenance of the APCS in such a manner so that the air emissions confirm with the prescribed standards.
4. Industry shall comply with the Charter on CREP for Sugar industries prepared by CPCB.
5. Latest copy of the Balance sheet/C.A. Certificate indicating (Fixed assets + Current Assets - Current Liabilities) shall be submitted for verification of the Consent fee payable by the industry.
6. Industry shall strictly comply with the provisions of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended and Environment (Protection), Act 1986.
7. The industry shall comply with the provisions of Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
8. Industry shall submit Environment Statement for the previous year within the stipulated period.
9. Industry shall be operated in such a manner so that there is no adverse impact on the environment and public health in surrounding.
10. Industry shall develop Green belt as per the Protocol attached with Board's office order H 16405/220/2018/02 dated 16-2-2018, which is available on Board's website: 'www.uppcb.com'.
11. Industry shall maintain Good House Keeping practices.
12. Fly Ash shall be disposed as per the Fly Ash notification issued by MoEF & CC issued in 2009.
13. With regards to the use of Pet Coke/Furnace Oil as Fuel, the orders passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the Writ petition (Civil) No.-13029/1985 M.C. Mehta versus Union of India and Others will be applicable.
14. If Closure order is issued by CPCB or UPPCB against any defaulting unit then CTO issued earlier will remain suspended during the closure period and after ensuring the compliance and after revocation of closure order, the CTO will automatically be effective with additional conditions mentioned in the closure revocation order.
15. The industry should follow the directions issued by the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change, Delhi vide Notification no. GSR 35(E) dated 14/01/2016.
16. Industry shall comply with the provisions of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
