Singh Thakur, accused of plotting the September 2008 Malegaon blast, but rejected the bail plea of co-accused former Lt Col Prasad Purohit, saying the charges against him were of grave nature.

The court said prima facie no case was made out against 44-year-old Thakur, who was arrested nine years ago, and asked her to furnish a cash surety of ₹5 lakh and surrender her passport to the National Investigation Agency (NIA).

It also directed her not to tamper with the evidence and to report to the NIA court as and when required.

"Prima facie there is no case

nearly 100 others injured when a bomb strapped to a motorcycle had exploded in Malegaon town of Nashik district on September 29, 2008.

Thakur and 44-year-old Purohit were arrested in 2008. While Thakur, who is suffering from cancer, is undergoing treatment at Madhya Pradesh hospital, Purohit is lodged in Talaja jail in Maharashtra.

The NIA, which was handed over the probe from ATS, had given a clean chit to Sadhvi Pragma and told the High Court that it had no objection to her being released on bail.

The agency had, however, opposed Purohit's bail plea.

UP ex-Minister Prajapati gets bail in rape case

Lucknow, April 25

Former UP minister Gayatri Prajapati and two of his alleged accomplices were on Tuesday granted bail by a POCSO court here in connection with a rape case.

A Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) court granted bail to Prajapati, while asking him to furnish two sureties of ₹1 lakh each and a personal bond of the same amount.

An FIR was registered against the Samajwadi Party leader and six others on February 17 on a directive of the Supreme Court.

After being on the run for nearly a month, Prajapati (49) was arrested from Aashiyana area here on March 15 and sent to jail for allegedly raping a woman and attempting to rape her minor daughter in 2014.

Prajapati has claimed that he is innocent and the charges were a conspiracy to malign him.

RSS training kids to kill: Pinarayi

Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Tuesday accused the RSS of training students and children to "kill" during its drill exercises in the State, a charge rubbished by the saffron outfit.

"Even students and children are given training to kill," Vijayan alleged in the Assembly. "The government would take steps to end the drill exercise of RSS," he said.

RSS rejected the allegations and said using the Assembly to "insult" the functions of RSS was an act of "cowardice." RSS leader P Gopalankutty Master asked the Chief Minister to desist from making such comments in the House under the cover of immunity.
